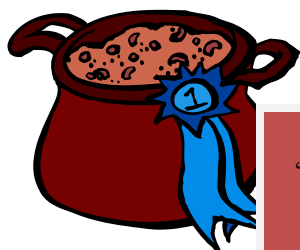

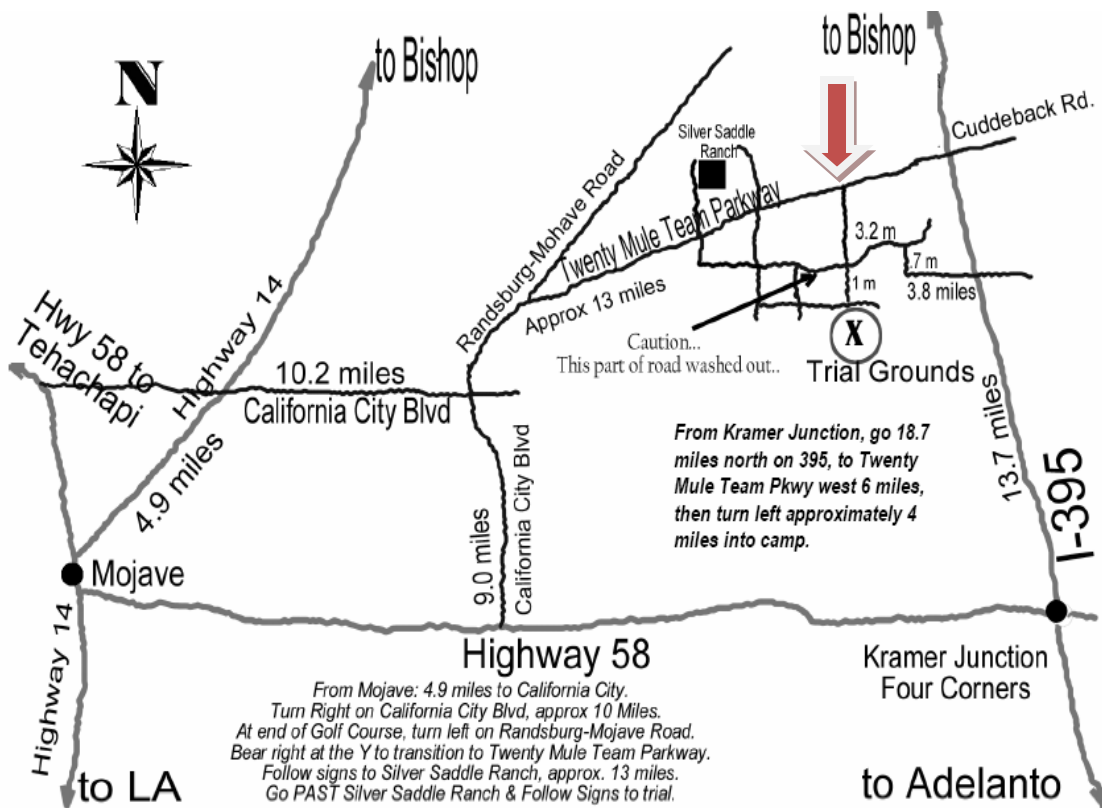

From Kramer Junction (395/58)
Go North on 395 18.7 miles
Turn left at the green CalTrans sign indicating **20 Mule Team/ Cuddeback Rd.**
Go west about 6.2 miles
Turn left and go about 1.5 miles into camp.
Signs will be posted.

From Mojave: 4.9 miles to California City. Turn Right on California City Blvd, approx 10 Miles. At end of Golf Course, turn left on Randsburg-Mojave Road. Bear right at the Y to transition to Twenty Mule Team Parkway. Follow signs to Silver Saddle Ranch, approx. 13 miles. Go PAST Silver Saddle Ranch & Follow Signs to trial.

From Kramer Junction, go 18.7 miles north on 395, to Twenty Mule Team Pkwy west 6 miles, then turn left approximately 4 miles into camp.
