






Nancy Hewitt A Happy Mom

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING, JUNE 1, 2002

President Bill Landress called the General Meeting to order at 2:58 PM on June 1, 2002. The meeting was held at Arcadia Park, Arcadia CA in conjunction with the California Brittany Club 41st Annual Specialty Show.

Secretary Report: Craig Lewis read the minutes of the last General Meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

Treasurers Report: Craig Lewis reported that the club had an income of approximately \$10,000 with expenses of \$14,000. 
