
In Place of the Letter from the Editor this issue, I would like to place a very interesting and important article that was posted for Dr. Gordon Theilen ...

Mary Jo Trimble yesterday

posted reference to an article in the NY Times entitled "Breeders Test DNA, Dogs Become Guinea Pigs". This is found on the web http:// www.nytimes.com/2007/06/1 2/science/12dog.html? r=1&hp&oref=slogan It points out the importance of finding genes from affected dogs with disease that often can be helpful in finding similar genes in humans, thus the term "dogs serve as quinea pigs". In this article whippet dogs were reported to have a defective gene in the big runners that may be true in humans as well. It is important for all of you to note, our own Dr. Mark Neff, who is in charge of the Center for Brittany DNA Studies at University of California at Davis, was quoted in the NY Times article.

Please note that the studies at the Veterinary Genetics Laboratory at Davis is studying the entire Brittany Genome, a unique approach to DNA studies and not done for any other breed anywhere. All other studies are looking at specific genetic defects. The UC Davis Lab is also looking at wanted and unwanted traits, not done anywhere. The entire genome, reason DNA samples from thousands of Brittanys are needed to pursue these goals. Nearly 1,000 samples have been collected so far. You, breeders and owners, are the important biologists in the field and working together with Dr. Neff and is staff great things will happen. Hundreds of you have contributed, please expand these efforts. Continue to collect DNA samples from your Brittanys and send to the Lab at Davis. The lab has begun to tackle the biggest Brittany genetic defect, hip dysplasia, many DNA samples are needed, please send samples from known hip dysplastic dogs and related normal

dogs. For additional infor-



If you have questions, I am always available to help. Thanks Mary Jo for the information given at the NY-Times, it stressed importance of DNA Studies that we started in 2004 initiated by the Marvin Nelson Jr. Memorial Fund and the Nelson family.





Judges Criteria - Current vs Suggested

The GWP Club Of Southern California is hosting a Judge's Seminar Saturday August 4, 2007 (Hunt Test) - Sunday August 5, 2007 (Field Trial)

The seminar will be conducted by AKC representative Mike Aldrich.

It will be held at the Sizzler Restaurant, 1750 Hamner Avenue, Norco, CA 92060

Cost of the Seminar is \$30 each day.

It is open to all prospective judges for both hunting tests and field trials.

AKC has adopted (or is thinking of doing so) many changes in judge's requirements, one of which is that judge's must attend a seminar once every 5 years.

This is your golden opportunity to meet that requirement.

The following chart shows AKC Scoring Criteria for Hunt Tests, and also printed are the new changes in Judges Requirements. We hope the information is helpful to those who plan to participate in Pointing Dog Hunt Tests.

Guidelines for Scoring AKC Pointing Breed Hunt Tests

<u>Scoring</u>	Interpretation	Explanation	Illustrative Examples		
0	Lack of Performance	Disqualification warranted by extreme departure(s) from standard or complete lack of performance.	Aggression, no find, refuses to acknowledge honor, gun shy, bird unfit for consumption, no point, extreme interference with brace mate, etc.		
1-4	Unacceptable Performance	Performance not to standard. Basic requirements not met. Significant fault(s) exhibited or major handler error(s).	Timid, does not hunt, bumps bird intentionally, flash point, out of sight too long, very disobedient, steals point, breaks point early, very ineffective retrieve, handler guides dog to bird, commands honor prior to acknowledgement, etc.		
5	Minimal Qualifying Performance	Performance barely meets requirements.	· · · ·		
			Excessive checking back, pottering, several "nonproductive" points, ignores likely cover, creeps on point or honor, point lacks intensity,		
6	Slightly Below Average Performance	Performance meets essential require- ments. Nothing unacceptable observed; however, there is a need for improve- ments.	repeated delayed response to commands, inefficient retrieve, etc.		
7	Average Qualifying Performance	Performance shows promise and meets essential requirements - could have been done more effectively.	Useful hunting pattern, hold point just long enough, completes the retrieve but drops bird just short of handler, responds to commands but not always as quickly as desired, moves a step or two on shot, etc.		
8-9	Outstanding Qualifying Performance	Performance exceeds essential requirements. A few minor areas for improvement may be observed.	Hunts intelligently with speed and stamina, shows very good intensity in difficult situations, no movement at shot, honors quickly, etc.		
10	Exceptional Qualifying Performance	Performance that significantly exceeds all requirements and is both efficient and effective.	Something really exceptional, i.e difficult blind retrieve, honors without handler present, multiple high quality finds, extreme intensity on point, no verbal commands, etc.		

Note: This guideline must be tempered by the testing level under consideration. A senior hunting dog must be scored with less tolerance than a junior hunting dog and a master hunting dog is expected to perform in a more refined manner than a senior hunting dog.

Discussion: The committee felt that requiring attendance at a seminar would impose a heavy burden depending on travel distance. On the other hand, some participants enjoy the seminars due to the discussions that are generated. Therefore the committee decided to allow for either a written test or attendance at a seminar.

Optional – either test or seminar. Vote: Unanimous, Yes

Written test or Seminar: Either attend a seminar or pass written test every 5 years

Discussion: Original proposal was attendance at seminar or written test every 4 years. The committee felt this was to frequent. Proposal was

modified to every 5 years.


