ABC Summer Specialty Sunday, May 25, 2008



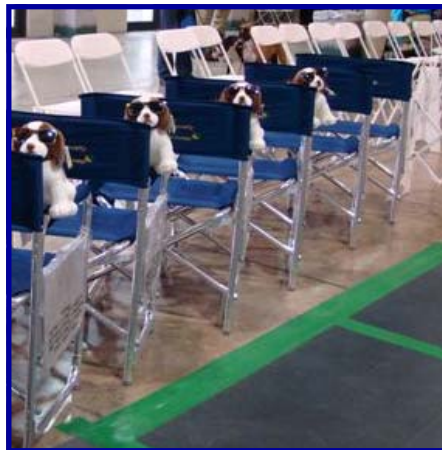

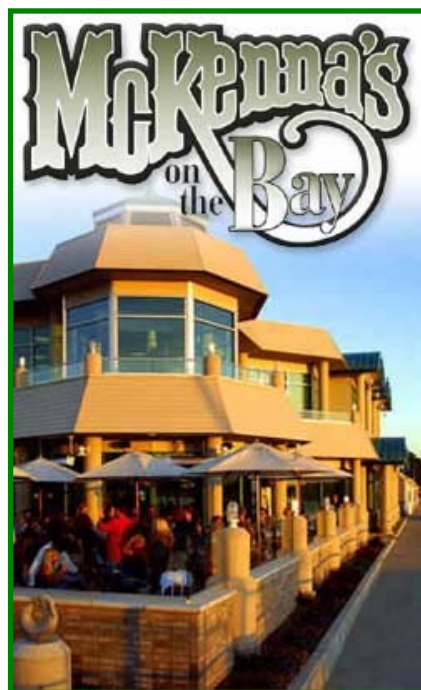
