#### 2018 CBC DOG OF THE YEAR AWARDS



### PROPOSED CHANGES OF TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

In the course of conducting the business of the California Brittany Club over the last few years as the previous First Vice President and now President, there are some observations and recommendations that I'd like to bring before the General Membership for comment and action. At the November 28, 2018 Board of Director's Meeting the subject of Officer Terms was discussed. Two aspects of this were discussed

as new business. First was extending officer terms to two years. The second part would be to split the board in half to have off-set terms. Half of the six members would be voted on each year. For example, offices of the President, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President and Treasurer would be up for elections on one year and the offices of 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President, 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice President and Secretary on the alternate years. This will provide for greater resilience and continuity with the board. Enables the board to execute events with more efficiencies because of the experience gained from the lengthened term and overlapping offices. It'll also reduce the administrative and business burdens associated with a complete board change out. Article VII, Section 4 of our current Constitution and Bylaws would have to change the term of office from one (1) to two (2) years.

Another aspect of Board of Directors' terms of office is the actual term start and stop dates. I propose a more logical term of office starting on July 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup>. With nominations and slate of officers finalized at the General Membership Meeting over the Memorial Day weekend, elections can and should be conducted and concluded by mid-June allowing the new members to step in as proposed. The reason I bring this change up is that our current process of filling a new board takes an inordinate amount of time with the standing board being in a lame-duck status for more than half of their current term. The second and more compelling reason for this change involves the Board's execution of club events. Planning and executing field and show events is no minor effort. It takes months of preparation. Under our current construct of placing a new board in January, the incoming officers are responsible for executing one of our club's biggest events two to three weeks after assuming office. The burden for planning is all incumbent upon the past board with no responsibility to execute. This is a recipe for disaster if you think about it. By changing the officer terms to July, the new board can practice their teamwork with the Willi Match, has enough time to plan and execute the Fall Field Trial and will be the "Pros from Dover" when it comes to the Spring Field Trial and Hunt Test. The final event for that board would be the annual Specialty held in late May. So, I believe it's evident the logical benefits of this proposal. If acted upon, it will require minor changes to Article VII, Section 2B and Section 3 of the current Constitution and Bylaws.

Under Article XII of the Constitution and Bylaws, a majority vote by attending members is required at the next General Membership and Annual Awards meeting, which will be held on May 26, 2019 at 2:00 pm right after the CBC Specialty Show, Redwood Picnic Area. This will be a subject of discussion at the next Board of Director's Meeting scheduled for April 17, 2019 at 7:00 pm via free telephone conferencing (contact information to be distributed via future email blast). The Board has affirmed its support of these changes and will present all comments received from the membership prior to

placing these for a vote at the General Membership Meeting. Please provide your comments to the Board as soon as possible.
